Easy Vie Bag

Sewing instructions

Requires approximately 1/2 yard for outer bag and 1/2 yard for lining.

Outer bag is best suited for heavier fabrics.

Lining is best suited for lightweight fabrics.

Print your pattern.

When printing, be sure to select "fit to printer margins" so you do not lose parts of the pattern. Assemble sheets to make bag pattern by matching the wedges in the corners.



Bag Body: Cut 2 in Fashion Fabric, Cut 2 in Lining Fabric Bag Bottom: Cut 1 in Fashion Fabric, Cut 1 in Lining Fabric

Options:

- 1. Cut pieces of lining fabric to make pockets for the inside.
- 2. Sew Timtex stiffener to the outer bag bottom to give the bag more body.

Assembly:

Note: All seam allowances are 3/8"

- 1. With right sides together, sew the to body sections together at the side seams. Press seams open.
- 2. Attach pockets (if any) to lining as desired.
- 3. Clip the seams at the marks along the bottom edge.
- 4. (optional) Baste Timtex to inside bag bottom.
- 5. Open out the bag and with right sides together, pin the bag bottom to the bag body, matching the marking symbols.
- 6. Stitch the bag bottom to the bag body, pivoting at the bottom corners. Press the seams.
- 7. Repeat the above steps for the lining, leaving an opening in the bottom to turn the bag right side out.
- 8. With right sides together, pin the lining to the bag, matching the top edges and time ends. Stitch.
- 9. Turn the bag right side out through the opening. Press top edge flat.
- 10. Slipstitch or edgestitch the opening in the lining.
- 11. Tie the tie ends in a knot to complete the bag.
