

# SUMMER TOTE #122 FROM LAZY GIRL DESIGNS

## MATERIAL LIST CORRECTION

March 23, 2006

Due to an error in the printing of the Summer Tote pattern from Lazy Girl Designs, the fabric requirement for the 'Outside Pockets and Handles' is 1" shorter than needed. I apologize for the error and we are correcting it.

### Make a note on your pattern:

The original printing reads: 'Outside Pockets and Handles - 1/2 yd (or 2 fat quarters)'. The correct yardage is '2/3 yd or 3 fat quarters' as shown below in the pink text.

Please make changes to the back panel of your pattern by crossing-out the '1/2' and writing in '2/3' for yardage, and crossing out the '2' and writing in '3' for fat quarters.

<b>FABRICS:</b>	Cover - 1/2 yd (or 2 fat quarters)
	Lining - 1/2 yd (or 2 fat quarters)
	<b>Outside Pockets and Handles - 2/3 yd (or 3 fat quarters)</b>
	Inside Pockets and Optional Sleeve - 1/2 yd (or 2 fat quarters)
<b>NOTE:</b>	Some dark/patterned lining fabrics might show through on light colored cover fabrics when the project is done. Hold fabrics wrong sides together to test.

Nothing else on the pattern needs to be changed.

### If you've already cut your fabric:

To resolve the problem if you only have 1/2 yard of fabric available, adjust the size of the back pocket as described and illustrated below.

- First, cut your handle pieces as close to the edge as possible. Cut a 4" wide strip, then cut that strip in half to make two pieces 4" x 22". You should have close to 14" of yardage left.
- Cut the back pocket piece at 19" x whatever yardage is left, which should be between 13" and 14". This is the only piece altered and this adjustment does not affect any other part of the project.
- Cut the front pocket piece from the remainder of the fabric.

Also consider substituting a different fabric for the handles then cut the back and front pockets to the correct size.

This suggested change does not change the usability of the design. The back pocket will be 1/2" to 1" shorter than originally designed when the project is complete. The Back Pocket can be cut as small as 19" x 13" with great results. Use the cutting diagram included to make the most of your fabric.



For future projects, buy 2/3 yd or 3 fat quarters for the Outside Pockets and Handles fabric requirement. Remember to note this on the 'Supplies' list on the back of your pattern.
