ew A Apron has halter style neck rap gathered to wide scalloped aistband, patch pockets, scalloped bitom edge, ties in back, and trim at ther edges of apron, top of pockets id waistband. View B flared apron is center front panel, patch pock-s, double bodice, trim at neckline, mholes and top of pockets, and is in back. Shaped pot holders are buble with batting between layers, we loop and trim at outer edges.
