

<u>Description</u> – Two panel skirt with side seams and center front seam with slit. Elastic waistband. Ease 1".

<u>Suggested</u> <u>Fabrics</u> – Use lightweight fabric with drape. Rayon, microfiber, silk, chiffon, cut velvet, stretch velvet and fine knits.

Notions - 1" wide non-roll elastic (see measurement chart on instruction sheet for length).
